



(4 sessions over 4 consecutive weeks)

COURSE FEES

PART 1: \$214.91 per pax (Before Subsidy)

(Subsidy for prevailing course fee for staff in eligible community care organisations – 90% for Singaporeans/ PRs and 45% for foreign staff)

PART 2: \$585 per pax (Before Subsidy)

(Subsidy from Chua Foundation – \$350 per pax/ \$500 for two pax, including a complimentary reminiscence start-up kit)
