Being able to converse in Mandarin, Cantonese, Hokkien and Teochew dialects, and Malay, comes in handy when working with the elderly and persons with dementia. While volunteering at a daycare centre prior to joining Dementia Singapore (formerly Alzheimer's Disease Association), I had encountered one case of a senior with dementia which left a deep impression on me - an 'ah ma' who suffered from elderly abuse and always came to the daycare with bruises. When I asked her about it, she would tell me it's because she fell down. One day, her bruises were quite bad and she was very weak, so we took her to hospital. When she was warded, I found out that her children had been abusing her as they were unable to manage her dementia condition. That experience spurred me to want to gain a better understanding of how or why a person gets dementia and I wanted so much to look after them.

It has been more than 15 years since I started working at New Horizon Centre (Tampines). When I first joined, I felt quite helpless as I didn't know how to handle clients with dementia. Thankfully, Mr Stephen Chan (ex-Centre Manager and current Director of Care Services), provided much needed guidance and imparted useful skills on caring for the persons with dementia.



Managing everyday activities can take a toll on the persons living with dementia and their caregivers. That's why it's important for all of us to treat them with care, concern and patience. I feel fulfilled seeing the happy looks on my clients' faces when we meet. Even though they can't tell me verbally, they say 'Thank You' through a touch of the hand or a smile. It is a very intimate feeling working with persons with dementia. They are like family to me. I want to be able to look after them and help to ease the load on their family, even if it is only for a few hours a day to provide them some respite.
